The Humpty Dumpty I am referring to is the United Methodist Church. Though it has had many names and joinings together and separations it has had one theme — that of following a man and to some point worshiping that man. It has come to the point that John Wesley and the Wesleyan way has become the total focus and the word of God has been superseded by methodistism. The worship of God and His son Jesus Christ has been put on the back burner and man's agenda has taken first place. Well, it has failed, and Humpty Dumpty has fallen and has splintered into a thousand pieces. Why did you not listen to the word and to God's warnings and instead chose to follow man's ways and allowed many evil ways and errors into the church? This did not happen in a moment, but you had many warnings for several years but with pride sat upon the great wall of Methodism and said I know better than God and want to do it my way. How sad and tragic for your many members that you betrayed and let go to destruction in ignorance.

There have been endless discussions about the methodist church splintering, but most have centered on trying to save the Methodist church organization and structure. Some are focused on staying as they are under the present UMC structure and some forming other Wesleyan way denominations, and some are focused on how to get out of the UMC to keep their present church property and operate as independent churches. But I see no focusing on why it came to this point and how to get back on track. None focused on what the real problem is and recognized that the UMC has lost their way and needed to repent and get back into the word of God again and believe what He has said. My concern is for the people in the pews that have trusted the leadership to teach them the truth of the word, but it has been corrupted by man's ideas and interpretations, but the word is not to be interpreted by man but is to be interpreted by the word and spirit of God.
